Breeding agreement – **Fresh/frozen semen**

This agreement is made between Mr. BUZZI GIANCARLO of Azienda Agricola Buzzi Giancarlo, Via Varesina 20, 21035 Cunardo (VA), hereafter referred to as Stallion Owner

(a copy of the pedigree is required in attachment)

and defines the terms governing the purchasing by the Mare Owner of one breeding/more breedings from the sire above identified.

The fee is **€ 5,000 each breeding**, (plus VAT 22% if private customer, VAT-free if firm or company) and **has to be paid in advance**. The costs of semen collections or production, handling and shipments have to be paid as following:

Fresh semen: the Mare Owner will receive an invoice with the total of collections and shipments used at the end of the season, as follows:

- collection: € 80.00; package: € 20.00 (styrofoam-box has not to be returned!)
- health certificate (if requested): € 50.00
- transport costs: depending on different carriers, delivery time and country.

Important: semen has to be ordered within 10.00 am

Frozen semen: the Mare Owner shall pay the following costs together with the breeding fee:

- Doses production: € 100.00 each (one dose: 4 straws)
- Semen handling:
 - ❖ flat rate per delivery within Europe: € 125.00
 - ❖ flat rate per delivery outside Europe: € 300.00
- Health Certificate:
 - ❖ within Europe: € 50.00
 - ❖ outside Europe: € 100.00
- Transport costs: depending on different carriers, delivery time and country.

(Note that within the handling fee is included the rental of the nitrogen tank, which has to be returned (shipment costs on Mare Owner) within seven days. After that period the customer shall pay € 100.00 for each day delayed. Should the tank get lost the customer shall be charged by € 2,000).

Based on these conditions, the Mare Owner has to pay:

The Mare Owner acknowledges that breeding/breedings and doses are non-transferable and cannot be re-sold or provided to any other party without informing the Stallion Owner in advance.

Stallion Manager shall provide semen from Stallion identified in this contract, and makes no other guarantee of the condition of the semen once the styrofoam-box or equitainer have left the stud.

The Mare Owner shall be responsible for semen storage, proper handling and insemination into the mare.

IMPORTANT: in order to facilitate the editing of the breeding certificates, the Mare Owner has to inform the Stallion Owner as soon as pregnancy has been confirmed.

TERMS

The term of this contract is TWO breeding seasons.

Should the mare fail to conceive, should she abort, die or not produce a "live foal" (live foal shall be defined a foal that stands and nurses without assistance for a period of at least 72 hours from the time of birth), then the Stallion Owner guarantees that Mare Owner shall have the right to rebreed or substitute the mare within the current or the following breeding season. **If a mare fails to settle after two seasons, for any reason, Mare Owner will hold Stallion Owner blameless, and the present contract shall be considered fulfilled. The semen purchase fee under this contract will be fully earned and nonrefundable.**

Should the mare fail to conceive, should she abort, die or not produce a "live foal" (live foal shall be defined a foal that stands and nurses without assistance for a period of at least 72 hours from the time of birth), Stallion Owner guarantees that

Mare Owner shall have the right to rebreed **or substitute the mare** within the current or the following breeding season.

In the event that mare does not produce a "live foal", the Mare Owner shall provide the Stallion Manager with a veterinarian's certificate stating the time and date of birth, time and date of death, and cause of death within seven days of aforementioned death.

In the event that mare dies, Mare Owner shall provide Stallion Manager with a veterinarian's certificate of death.

THIS BREEDING PROPOSAL IS VALID FOR THE 2014 BREEDING SEASON. SHOULD THE MARE OWNER AGREE WITH ITS TERMS AND DECIDE TO PURCHASE THE BREEDING, THEY MUST RETURN THIS CONTRACT DULY FILLED TO THE STALLION OWNER **WITHIN ONE MONTH** FROM ITS RECEIPT.
